

CALL FOR ASSOCIATE DIRECTORS

The Sotoyome RCD's Board of Directors is looking for individuals who are interested in becoming Associate Directors.

Any landowner or individual residing within the Sotoyome Resource Conservation District boundaries, who is 21 years of age or older, is eligible to serve as an Associate Director by appointment of the Board of Directors. To be appointed the individual must have a sincere interest in resource conservation and be willing to commit to the time needed to fulfill their assigned tasks required for the implementation of the District's annual and long-range plans, accomplishment of its mission, or to assist the District with implementation of its duties. Appointment as an Associate Director is especially encouraged for those registered voters who wish to become full Directors in accordance with Division IX of the California Public Resource Code.

Appointment:

After review of an application for appointment as Associate Director, and determination that the individual has the qualifications for furthering the work and objectives of the District, the Board of Directors may resolve to adopt a notification of appointment to be included in the minutes of the appropriate Board of Directors meeting.

Term of Office:

All appointments as an Associate Director will be for two years and will be reviewed biannually before the end of the fiscal year on June 30th.

Meeting Attendance:

Associate Directors are expected to attend District Board meetings or RCD related events at least six times a year, and are particularly encouraged to attend the annual planning meetings. An Associate Director serves as an advisor and is not a voting member of the Board.

Duties:

Duties or tasks to be accomplished by Associate Directors are described and approved by the Board of Directors. Specifically, all Associate Directors' activities should complement and reinforce the annual and long-range plans/goals of the District as directed and approved by the Board of Directors.

Compensation:

Associate Directors, just like Board members, volunteer their time and do not receive compensation for work they perform on behalf of the District, except for related travel expenses or purchases.
